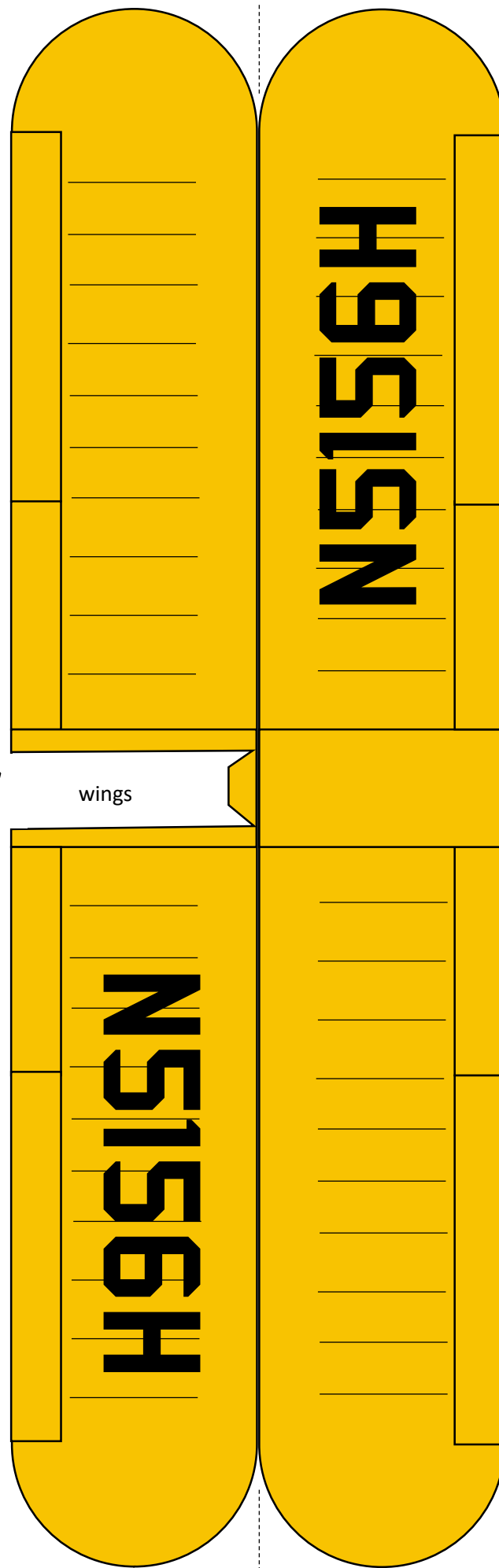
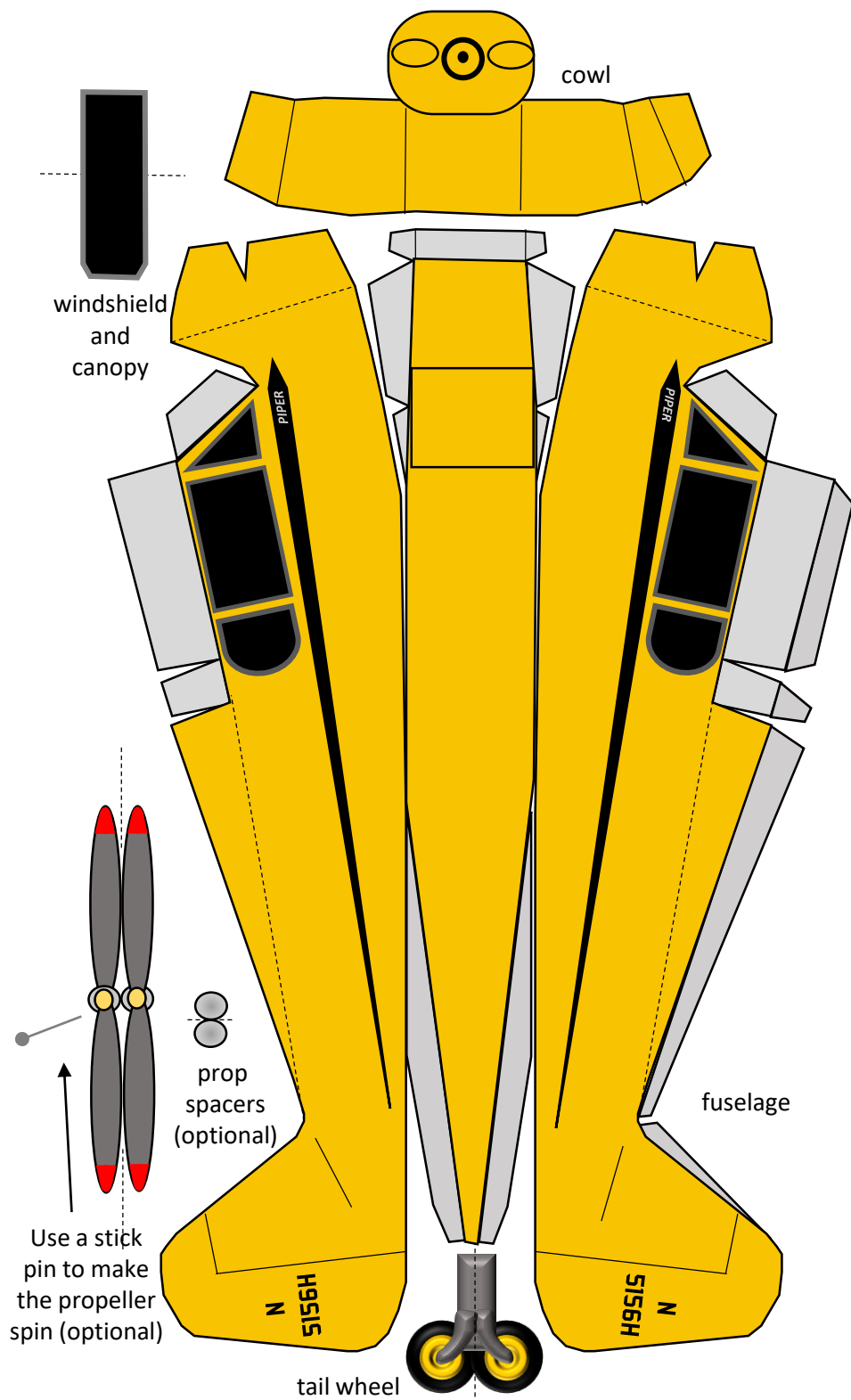

Nate Saint, the pilot, and four of his missionary friends flew deep into the jungles of Ecuador, a country in South America.

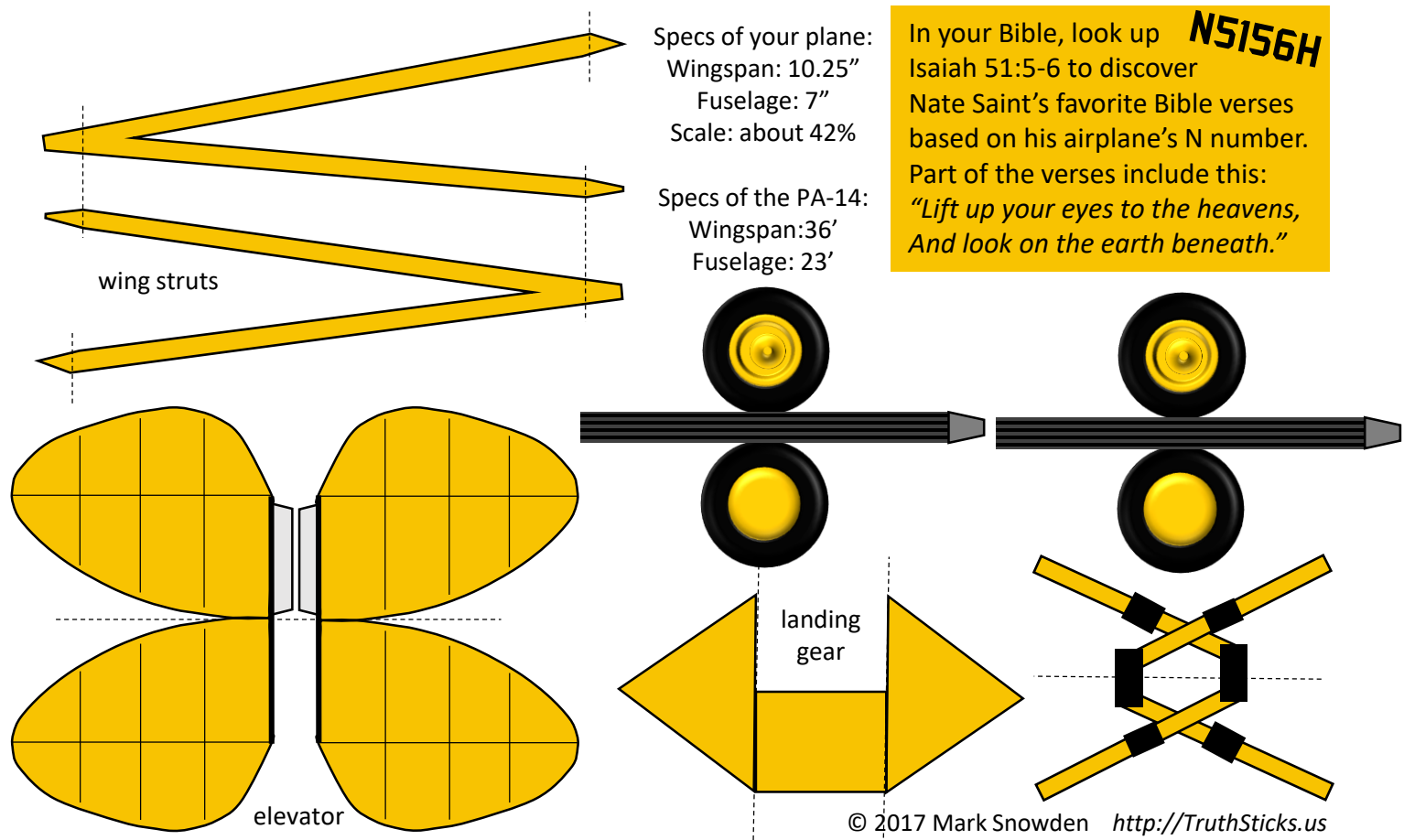
